Public Comments: Neighbor opposed to the 25 units proposed (agenda item); announcement of PLUM hearing regarding Weatherwolde Castle to be held Feb. 28; LAPD drop in center will open March 18 at NVCH; groundbreaking date for Ford Property is 99% certain for March 25; Dale Thrush announced receipt of two copies of proposed Home Depot tenant improvement plans (one copy for CD2 and one copy passed to No2Home Depot group).

## Presentations:

10344 Leolang – Developers asking for hardship exemption to the FAR ICO. Much discussion about their plans exceeding the 40% limitation, including the garage. This is precedent setting. Discussion and Q&A from neighbors in the audience and DAC opposing this request. Motion that DAC does not recommend a hardship exemption for this proposed development. Motion passed unanimous with roll call vote.

9166 Tujunga Canyon Blvd. – Existing site of Oakview Convalescent. Proposal is for a 25 unit condo project. Includes a 9' dedication along Tujunga Canyon. Discussion and Q&A from DAC and public about the street, traffic and setback dedication. Motion that DAC does not support this project as presented. A full traffic study, Environmental Impact Report and only most restrictive zoning should be required. Motion passed unanimous with roll call vote.
